We bake muffins once a month.

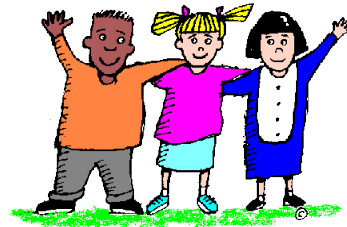
Our program is full of surprises.

Bible Class

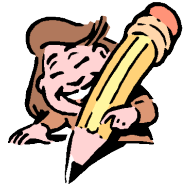
This class is geared toward the older children in the parish.

We meet near the choir cupboards and have a couch and some chairs for comfort.

Each child has their own clipboard with a memory verse ring attached. The plan is to receive a memory verse related to each lesson and then for the children to take the memory verse ring home in June to keep as a reference to scripture.

We have a bulletin board for our attendance and other interesting items that arise during our lessons, such as these:

For attendance, each child adds a new letter of the name Jesus each time they attend. There is small prize every time they complete the name of Jesus.

The idea of the group is to follow the life and teachings of Jesus to better know Him and to become familiar with his teachings to us. We are using the Gospel of Luke to carry out this plan.

Many times we move off topic somewhat to discuss things that come up in the lives of the children that they would like to discuss, such as: "most of my friends are not believers and why do we have to go to church?"

We also pray for things that are concerning us directly in our lives or in the lives of those in need as this is an important communication link to God and a comfort to our souls.

The students love quizzes, word-finds, crosswords and Bible games and so these things are often integrated into the lessons.
